Signer Identification Requirements

Valid IDs You'll Need for Your Online Notarization

To comply with state and federal law, every signer must present valid identification during a Remote Online Notarization (RON).

Acceptable Forms of ID:

- U.S. State-Issued Driver's License (unexpired, government issued)
- U.S. Passport (book or card, valid and current)
- State-Issued Identification Card (non-driver ID)
- Military ID (active duty, reserve, or retired)
- Green Card / Permanent Resident Card (USCIS issued)

Not Accepted:

- Expired IDs
- Social Security Cards
- Birth Certificates
- Temporary Paper IDs

Requirements:

- Must be current & unexpired
- Must contain a photo, signature, and description that matches the signer
- All signers must be physically present on camera during the notarization

Quick Tip:

Prepare your ID before your appointment to ensure a smooth notarization.
